Safety assessments should include all staff involved with the operation and any conclusions / procedures arising from such assessments should be clearly communicated to all relevant staff.

All staff employed at MechaTech Systems Ltd are encouraged to participate in Health and Safety issues and any Health and Safety concerns should be communicated to the Safety Officer, his advisor or the nominated worker representative. A Workplace Safety Committee has been established to review Health and Safety issues. The Safety Officer, his advisor and the nominated worker representative form the basis of this committee.
- 6. MechaTech Systems Ltd agrees to comply with current UK health and safety legislation.

The company is committed to continued improvement and will commit the necessary financial and physical resources to fulfil this commitment.

Keith Cassam	Recording / reporting and investigating accidents
Keith Cassam	Annual safety checks
Keith Cassam	Emergency Procedures – Fire and evacuation

Risk Assessments

Risk assessments will be undertaken by the Safety Officer in cooperation with the personnel that are subjected to the risk and the relevant line manager. The relevant line manager will then be responsible for ensuring that any actions arising from the risk assessment are implemented. Assessments will be reviewed every 1 year or when the work activity changes, whichever is the soonest.

The Employee Representative is Keith Cassam.

The Employee Representative can take up any concerns about Health and Safety with the Safety Officer at any time and is also a member of the workplace safety committee, which meets to discuss safety issues. Full details of the safety committee are given below:
